THREE-POINT LIGHTING
















A CHEAP RIG for a LIVE iPhone shoot: LIGHT from BOTH SIDES of the phone, and set a BOUNCE card at the TOP. If you want to SHOOT a PORTRAIT app, TURN your camera 90°, so the video FRAME MATCHES your phone's orientation.

HOW DO I MAKE IT BETTER?

It's a lot MORE WORK, but TURN OFF the CAPTURE of the POINTER altogether, and ANIMATE your own. That way, WHEN YOU CUT your video, your POINTER won't keep JUMPING all over the place. You can make it MOVE SMOOTHLY and draw ATTENTION only WHEN it NEEDS TO.

HOW DO I MAKE IT BETTER?

- Invest in a quality microphone.
- ☐ Script out your voiceover.



MAKE IT EASY FOR THEM

- ☐ Format: QuickTime or MPEG-4 in H.264
- ☐ Mac video:
 - □ 640x360 for YouTube
 - ☐ 960x540 (half-HD) is great for detail
- ☐ iPhone video:
 - □ 320x480 vertical
